DUCTLESS HEAT PUMP PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Applicable for electric homes

- A minimum 8.1 HSPF2 (Heating Seasonal Performance Factor) and 16 SEER2 (Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio) are required.
- Work must be completed by a [program-participating HVAC contractor](#).
- Gas, oil, wood, pellet stoves and propane system conversions do not qualify for Electric Resistance Heat Conversion rebates. **Note:** A supplemental heating rebate is available for gas-heated homes.
- Ductless heat pump must be installed according to the specifications outlined in the [Wyoming Technical Specifications Manual](#).
- Ductless heat pump must be a new AHRI* rated ductless (mini-split) system and must be listed on the AHRI Certified Directory: [AHRIDirectory.org](#).
- Ductless heat pump must employ an inverter-driven outdoor compressor unit and a variable speed fan for indoor blower and be fully ductless.

Single-head and Multi-head DHPs additional requirements

- Previous primary heat source must have been a permanently installed electric resistance heating system (e.g., electric furnace, electric ceiling/wall heat) serving at least 80% of the home's conditioned living space.
- Incentive is not offered to customers replacing an existing heat pump.

Supplemental DHPs additional requirements

- Gas and propane heated homes qualify for a supplemental rebate when using a ductless heat pump system for bonus rooms or additions.
- Primary heat source (natural gas or propane) must be in service and remain operational.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM RULES

- Homes are eligible for one (1) unit. For two (2) units or more, please contact the program before applying.
- For a multifamily property [up to three (3) units per foundation], please submit one application per unit. For four (4) or more units, see [Multifamily rebate](#) details.

- Existing single-family homes only, not for New Construction.*

CUSTOMER ELIGIBILITY

Residential electric customers in Wyoming who purchase their electricity from Rocky Mountain Power on rate schedules 2 or 19 qualify. Landlords who own rental properties served by the company in Wyoming where the tenant is billed on rate schedules 2 or 19 also qualify for this program.

HOW TO APPLY

Step 1: Find a Contractor

Prior to starting a project, find a [program-participating HVAC contractor](#), and review the rebate qualifications together.

Step 2: Apply online

Apply online with the required documents within 90 days of project completion.

Step 3: Status

Receive your check. Rebate checks are issued within 14 business days after we review and approve your rebate application.
